These students are considered eligible for HOPE, but in order to receive HOPE, they must meet academic requirements (a 3.0 in core high school courses). This column also includes any additional first-time freshmen receiving HOPE according to GSFC records but who did not appear in SIRS as Georgia high school graduates. This report includes only those students who received the HOPE Scholarship; it does not count HOPE Grant recipients as scholarship recipients.
